The gravel roads on Moresby Island are built for industrial use by the logging companies and are radio controlled. Logging traffic will be on these roads primarily from 6am - 6pm, Monday to Friday. Frequently, there will be logging traffic evenings and weekends as well. Lowbeds, company pickups and graders will be on these roads AT ANY TIME.

**AT ALL TIMES DRIVE AS THOUGH THERE WILL BE A LOGGING TRUCK (16' WIDE) AROUND EVERY CORNER**

When travelling on these roads, please:

- drive with headlights on
- 50 kph maximum speed
- obey all signs

ALWAYS CHECK WITH THE SANDSPIT VISITOR INFO CENTER BEFORE YOU VENTURE OUT ON THESE GRAVEL ROADS. Once you leave Sandspit, there is limited cell phone coverage (if any), no drinking water, no gas, no food etc. Be sure to tell someone where you are going and contact them when you return.

When you stop, park well off industrial roads and away from corners or bends. Logging trucks with long loads can damage vehicles parked too close to the road on the curve.

Visitors using industrial roads do so at their own risk and companies are not liable for damages and compensation arising from such use.

- Onward Point - 7.3km
- Copper Bay - 10.5km
- Alliford Bay - 13.5 km
- Skidegate Lake - 24.5km
- Gray Bay - 25.3km
- Mosquito Lake - 38.5 km
- Moresby Camp - 46km
